

The CLD de Brome-Missisquoi announces another project call in social economy

Brome-Missisquoi, March 3rd, 2009. Social economy businesses that wish to receive funding have until the 30th of March to submit a business plan to the CLD de Brome-Missisquoi.

Social economy is a form of collective entrepreneurship where goods or services are sold in order to improve the quality of life of its members or answer an important need of society. A classic example of a social economy business is a non-profit daycare center. They are run by an elected board of directors and they answer the needs of their members by providing a daycare service for children aged 0 to 5 years old.

Only non-profit organisations and cooperatives are eligible for funding. To submit a request for financing, organisations must contact Tania Szymanski, rural development and social economy advisor in order to prepare a business plan.
